2025 - 2026 Go to High School, Go to College Scholarship Application Requirements

Eligibility Criteria

Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. Theta Theta Lambda Chapter will select high school seniors who demonstrate success in the following categories:

Excellence Scholarship (\$2,500)
Leadership Scholarship (\$2,000)
Community Service Scholarship (\$1,500)
Diversity and Inclusion Scholarship (\$1,000)
Continuing Relationship Scholarship (\$500)

To be eligible, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Graduating Senior attending a Department of Defense (DODEA) High School in Germany
- Minimum Grade Point Average (GPA): **Weighted** cumulative GPA of 2.5 to 3.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Active participation in extracurricular activities and community service

Application Requirements

To apply, please submit the following documents:

- Complete and sign Scholarship Application Form (legal guardian information and signature required for applicants under 18)
- Official High School transcript (with **weighted** GPA)
- Copy of college acceptance letter, if available
- Scholarship recipients are required to provide proof of college enrollment prior to the distribution of funds.
- Typed Scholarship Essay of 750 - 1000 words, responding to one (1) of the prompts provided.
- At least (2) letters of recommendation from esteemed community leaders (one **MUST** be an academic reference with official school letterhead and/or official signature block)

2025 - 2026 Go to High School, Go to College Scholarship Essay Requirements

Excellence Scholarship

- Academic: Minimum GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Academic Excellence: A history of superior academic standings and leadership involvement in extracurricular activities, clubs, and community organizations.
- Essay: Discuss the importance of education and how the applicant plans to further contribute to the development of self and others during college.

Leadership Scholarship

- Academic: Minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Leadership Experience: A history of leadership roles in school and community activities. (ex. club president, team captain, organizing school/community events.)
- Essay: Discuss the importance of leadership roles in school, community, or extracurricular activities and how their personal experiences will help them navigate college life.

Community Service Scholarship

- Academic: Minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Community Engagement: A history of volunteering and community service, demonstrating a dedication to helping others.
- Essay: Discuss what it means to be selfless and the importance of service to others through volunteering, community involvement, and how the applicant plan to contribute their service at college.

Diversity and Inclusion Scholarship

- Academic: Minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Inclusive Activities: Involvement in initiatives that promote diversity and inclusion within the school or community.
- Essay: Discuss the importance of diversity of thought in community/education and how the applicant plans to contribute to a more inclusive environment during their collegiate years.

Continued Relationship Scholarship - (Previous Scholarship Recipient)

- Academic: Minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Inclusive Activities: Attending college
- Essay: 500 words - concisely discuss the impact of Theta Theta Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. scholarships award on college success.

Supporting Documentation:

Submission essay, recommendation letter(s), college acceptance letter(s), application signature page with parent or legal guardian signature (for applicants under 18), and the **official weighted transcript signed/stamped by school official (Principal, Guidance Counselor, or Administrator)**.
